

Malwa's Delight

Duration: 4 Nights/ 5 Days

Places Covered : Indore-Ujjain-Omkareshwar-Maheshwar -Mandu

Day 1 Mumbai -Ujjain

Arrive Indore by Awantika Express and meet our representative on arrival. Proceed to the hotel and check in. After some refreshments, get ready to visit Ujjain City (55 Km from Indore), a very important Hindu Pilgrimage destination. Mahakaleshwar Temple, Kal Bhairav Temple, Sandipani ashram, Harsiddhi Shaktipeeth. After darshan, back to Indore city. Day ends in Ujjain.

Day 2 Ujjain- Mandu

Early breakfast and this particular day, we will head to Mandu, 145 kms from Indore City. We will visit Rani Roopmati palace, Baaz Bahadur Palace, Jami Masjid, Jahaz Mahal, Hindola Mahal. Dinner at Hotel. Overnight stay in Mandu.

Day 3 Mandu – Maheshwar-Omkareshwar-Indore: (Total 200 KMS).

After an early breakfast, we will start for Maheshwar. Maheshwar has beautiful ghats built across the Narmada River. Maheshwar is also famous for Maheshwari Fabric. After lunch, start for Omkareshwar, yet another most visited jyotirlinga. After the darshan of Mandhata and Mamleshwar start for Indore. Enroute, we will visit the Khajrana Mandir, the famous Ganesh Idol. Day ends in Indore.

Day 4 Indore City

Today, keep a relaxed morning. Breakfast and we will today visit Indore, the City with history and loved by the foodies. Indore is a city in west-central India. It's known for the 7-story Rajwada Palace and the Lal Baag Palace, which date back to Indore's 19th-century Holkar dynasty. The Holkar rulers are honored by a cluster of tombs and cenotaphs at Chhatri Baag. The night market Sarafa Bazar sells street food. East is the Indo-Gothic Gandhi Hall and clock tower. The Jain temple Kanch Mandir has a mirrored mosaic interior. Day ends in Indore.
