

Bhopal Islamic Religious Tour

Day 1: Bhopal -

Tour starts form Bhopal, the city of lakes. You will be picked up from the location of your choice in Bhopal and transferred to the hotel. Located at Chowk Bazaar, the Jama Masjid in Bhopal was constructed in 1837 by Begum Qudsia and took 24 years to be completed. The golden spikes in the minarets are not to be missed. The Moti Masjid, on the other hand, was constructed by Begum Qudsia's daughter, Sikandar Jahan Begum in 1860 and looks like the replication of the Jama Masjid in New Delhi with its gold-topped minarets. Both the places are uber-impressive and cannot be missed. Possibly one of the largest mosques in Asia, spread a little over 23,000 square feet, the Taj Ul Masjid literally translates to 'the crown of mosques'. The construction of the mosque was initiated under the rule of Begum Shah Jahan (1868 – 1901), but could not be completed before her death owing to lack of funds. It was later completed only in 1971. The entrance to the mosque is a two-storeyed gateway with archways. The monument is regal with its pink façade, intricate carvings on its pillars as well as its ceiling, the expansive courtyard and smooth marble flooring. But it is the 206 ft tall (18 storey high) minarets that are the most breath-taking feature of the mosque. The Chowk Bazaar in Bhopal is the market road or bazaar road that provides direct access to shops with a touch of the old world through the mosques and havelis that are a beautiful blend of both Hindu and Islamic architecture lined up along it. The shops promise to be a sheer delight for anyone interested in traditional arts and crafts, silver jewellery or embroidered and beadwork. In the same vein, the street food is definitely worth a bite or two and then some more. Come back to the hotel & relax Overnight stay.

Day 2: Bhopal-
