



Shiv Temples Pilgrimage Tour

Duration: 3 Nights /4 Days

Destinations Covered: Bhopal - Bhojpur – Salkanpur - Pachmarhi - Bhopal

Day 01: Bhopal – Bhojpur-

This morning you will be visiting Bhojpur temple.

The tiny village of Bhojpur is situated on the bank of river Betwa. Bhojpur is famous for remains of magnificent Shiva Temple and Cyclopean dam dated 1010-53 A.D. You will come back to Bhopal in the evening and staying here tonight.

Day 02: Bhopal - Salkanpur - Pachmarhi-

Today, early in the morning you start the journey to visit Salkanpur.

Salkanpur is about 70 km from Bhopal. The Salkanpur temple is devoted to goddess Durga and the presiding deity here is MaaDurgaBeejasan, one of the incarnations of the goddess Durga. The Temple is situated on an 800 ft high hillock and have more than 1000 stairs and road is also available to reach the top at temple. After Salkanpur, you will route towards Pachmarhi. We will reach Pachmarhi in the evening and check-in to a hotel. You may opt to spend rest of the evening strolling through the streets of Pachmarhi and look around the town. For your safety, we advise you not to venture in the jungle or cross the town limits in the night as the predators are on prowl once it is dark.

You will be staying overnight in Pachmarhi.

Day 03: Pachmarhi-

Today we will have full day guided tour of Pachmarhi with visiting Bee Fall, known as JamunaPrapat, the Bee fall is located 3 km from the town and provides drinking water to Pachmarhi is famous for its bathing pools and spectacular backdrop. On the sightseeing tour of the region visit Tamiya, is a beautiful resort located 78 km from Pachmarhi. The place overlooks Narmada valley and provides some spectacular view of the Dudhi plateau. The sunset point of the place gives some magnificent views of the setting sun.

The beauty of the Satpura hills girdling the landscape of Tamiya can be best witnessed from this spot. Bori and Pachmarhi Sanctuaries constitute a part of 'Pachmarhi Biosphere Reserve', along with the Satpura National Park. Both these wildlife resorts cover a total area of 4501.91 km. Bori range stretches from the foot of the Pachmarhi hills to the Tawa and Denwa rivers and is located deep in the valleys. Panchmari sanctuary is harbored at the top. Enveloped with thick forests of teak and sal groves, they help tourists to explore the various species of birds of the region.



Day 04: Pachmarhi – Bhopal-

After Breakfast we will depart to Bhopal for onward connection.
Tour ends today.
