



Khajuraho World Heritage

Duration: 3 Nights/ 4 Days

Day 01: Bhopal - Khajuraho-

Tour starts from Bhopal, the city of lakes. You will be picked up from the location of your choice in Bhopal and begin 410 kms journey towards Khajuraho. You will be staying in Khajuraho tonight.

Day 02: Khajuraho-

After breakfast, visit western and eastern group of temples. The Western group of temples is the best known, because it is to this group that the largest and most typical Khajuraho temple belongs. Kandariya Mahadeo, Chaunsat Yogini, Chitragupta Temple, Vishwanath Temple and Lakshamana Temple belong to the western group. In the eastern group, the temples are the Brahma temple, which has a four-faced lingam, The Vamana temple which is embellished with images of ravishing apsaras at their alluring best; and finally the Javari temple, with its ornate gateway and lavish carvings. You will be staying in Khajuraho tonight.

Day 03: Khajuraho-

Visit Pandav Falls and Panna National Park during the day. Pandav Falls is a picturesque waterfall in a bowl-shaped valley on the Ken River. Later visit to Panna National Park. Return back to Khajuraho in the evening. You will be staying overnight in Khajuraho.

Day 04: Khajuraho - Bhopal-

After breakfast, we will start journey towards Bhopal. You will be arriving Bhopal in the evening. Tour concluded in Bhopal. Dhoopgarh where you will enjoy the scenic views of Satpura Hills and sunset and explore Reech Garh. You can also visit the Museum over there. Return to your hotel for overnight stay.

Day 3 - Sightseeing

After having breakfast, continue your tour again and spend your day by visiting Bada Mahadev, Gupt Mahadev, and Jata Shankar. You can shop for rare and unique herbs like Shilajeet and Forest Honey at Jatashankar. After lunch, have a boating trip to Pachmarhi Lake and return to the hotel for overnight stay.



Day 4 - Departure

After breakfast, check out and proceed to Nagpur with our representative. He will transfer you to the railway station, airport or hotel in Nagpur for your onward journey.
